CARMEL COLLEGE MAJOR AWARD NOMINATION CRITERIA



To assist in determining the recipients of Major awards students are asked to self-nominate for relevant awards. A number of factors are considered in the final selection of award recipients with recipients selected from the whole student cohort not just nominations. Self-nomination will however help ensure all relevant information is considered as staff cannot be aware of everything a student does or is involved in.

Generic criteria for all awards include achievement, behaviour, attendance, involvement in school life and the upholding of school values.

Students who wish to nominate for awards must complete the nomination form and return it to Mr Chalmers by the due date shown for the particular award. You may nominate for multiple awards if you believe you meet the criteria.

Outstanding Contribution to School Sport Award	This award is presented to a Year 12 student who has consistently contributed to sport at Carmel College from Year 7 through to Year 12. It is awarded to a student who has • Attended and actively participated in most interhouse carnivals since Year 7 • Consistently represented Carmel College at Bayside and SECA Carnivals as a competitor and/or official. • Represented Carmel College consistently in co-curricular sporting opportunities. • Demonstrated leadership qualities by showing a willingness to help out when needed.
Outstanding Contribution to Carmel College Arts Award	 Displays the values of the college at all times during representation Displays initiative in assisting with arts events, functions, equipment Volunteers to instruct or fill in Encourages and supports the participation of others Displays reliability Representing the College in ensembles Shown commitment to rehearsals
Kaitlyn Legarda Award	The recipient is a student who is outstanding and committed to performance arts with a special emphasis on dance and movement. The Kaitlyn Legarda Award recognises a student from the Carmel College community who has shown these fine qualities.
Carmel College Personal Endeavour Award	Award recipient is a student who has over their time at the College, demonstrated consistent diligence, despite challenging circumstances. This student's determination, commitment and desire have led them to become more confident and achieve their academic goals.
Excellence in Christian Leadership Award	The Christian Leadership award is awarded to a student from the senior years who has been active in college liturgies, promotes the charism of the College and displays strong Catholic leadership.
Generosity of Spirit Award	Award is presented to a student who displays selfless commitment to all aspects of the College and does so with great humility and a cheerful disposition. (Memorial Award - Roberta McShane Teacher 2015)
Faye Conley Scholarship Award Year 10	This scholarship is given to a student in Year 10 who has displayed consistently high academic achievements, as well as participating fully in the life of the College.

Rotary Club of Cleveland Scholarship Award (1 x Year 10 & 1 x Year 11 student)	Award is given to two students who have demonstrated outstanding leadership within the school and the wider community. (One from Year 10 and One from Year 11)
Rotary Club of Capalaba Award (Year 12) Australian Defence Force Leadership Award - Year 10 & Year 12	Awarded to Year 12 student who the College recognises as being involved in all aspects of student life including academic, community, and extracurricular activities. This student demonstrates strong leadership qualities and outstanding character attributes. (Year 12 student) The recipients of this award have demonstrated leadership qualities, are strong team players and are actively engaged in community activities. These students can be relied upon to produce feasible solutions to problems and they are effective in creating harmonious working environments. In addition, they are competent communicators and show a strong regard for the values of the College and Community. 2 Students - 1 x Year 10 and 1 x Year 12.
Australian Defence Force Future Innovators Award (Year 10 and Year 12)	The Australian Defence Force is encouraging the next generation of innovators, critical thinkers and problem solvers – bright Australian students who are succeeding in STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Maths). (Each successful recipient receives cash and a certificate of achievement). 2 Students - 1 x Year 10 and 1 x Year 12.
The Ampol All-Rounder Award Year 12	This Award is presented to a Year 12 student who does not necessarily display champion qualities in any one field but whose overall personal achievement, involvement and contribution in a range of areas is outstanding.
Achievement in Non-School Activities – Sport, Arts, Other	The Award recipients receive the Outstanding Achievement in Non-School Activities for achieving at a high level in competitions or events not directly associated with the school program. Possible examples could include: • Represented Queensland • Represented Australia • Achieved a significant placing at a state, national or world championships (eg. won a medal, finished top 3) • Achieved any other similarly significant accomplishment
